G	A. A radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless (Ephesians 5:27)

A	A. Their own bodies (Ephesians 5:28)

A	A. One flesh (Ephesians 5:31)
	What is a profound mystery?
G	A. That a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will

	become one flesh (Ephesians 5:31)
G	Who will become one flesh? A. The two (a man and his wife) (Ephesians 5:31)
G	Whom will a man leave to be united to his wife? A. His father and mother (Ephesians 5:31)
A	According to Ephesians 5:32, about what is Paul talking? A. Christ and the church (Ephesians 5:32)
G	How must each one of you love his wife? A. As he loves himself (Ephesians 5:33)
G	Who must respect her husband? A. The wife (Ephesians 5:33)
G	Whom must the wife respect? A. Her husband (Ephesians 5:33)
