X	Two part question: What if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you and what if anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted? A. 1) Let them be under God's curse and 2) let them be under God's curse (Galatians 1:8-9)
X	Complete, in essence, the following: "Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings,.." A. "...or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ." (Galatians 1:10)
X	In Galatians chapter 1, to where had Paul returned? A. Damascus (Galatians 1:17)
X	What name is Cephas also known as? A. Peter (Galatians 1:18)
X	What two apostles are mentioned in Galatians chapter 1? A. Cephas (that is, Peter) and James (the Lord's brother) (Galatians 1:18-19)
X	Two-part question: In Galatians chapter 2, who went up again to Jerusalem and who came to Antioch? A. 1) Paul and 2) Cephas (that is, Peter) (Galatians 2:1, 11)
X	What two cities are mentioned in Galatians chapter 2? A. Jerusalem and Antioch (Galatians 2:1, 11)
X	In Galatians chapter 2, who was a Greek? A. Titus (Galatians 2:3)
X	Who recognized that I had been entrusted with the task of preaching the gospel to the uncircumcised? A. Those who were held in high esteem (Galatians 2:6-7)
X	Two-part question: In Galatians chapter 2, who was an apostle to the circumcised and who was an apostle to the uncircumcised? A. 1) Peter and 2) Paul (Galatians 2:8)
X	Who asked that we should continue to remember the poor? A. James, Cephas (that is, Peter) and John (Galatians 2:9-10)
X	Complete, in essence, the following: "All they asked was that we should ..." A. "... continue to remember the poor, the very thing I had been eager to do all along." (Galatians 2:10)
X	In Galatians chapter 2, who were not acting in line with the truth of the gospel? A. Cephas, Barnabas and the other Jews (Galatians 2:11-14)
X	From what Old Testament book is the following: "Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness." A. Genesis (Galatians 3:6)

X	What Old Testament person is mentioned in Galatians chapter 3? A. Abraham (Galatians 3:6)
X	From what Old Testament book is the following: "All nations will be blessed through you."? A. Genesis (Galatians 3:8)
X	From what Old Testament book is the following: "Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law."? A. Deuteronomy (Galatians 3:10)
X	From what Old Testament book is the following: "The righteous will live by faith."? A. Habakkuk (Galatians 3:11)
X	From what Old Testament book is the following: "The person who does these things will live by them."? A. Leviticus (Galatians 3:12)
X	From what Old Testament book is the following: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole."? A. Deuteronomy (Galatians 3:13)
X	Two-part question: In Galatians chapter 4, of whom was God's Son born and under what was God's Son born? A. 1) Of a woman and 2) under the law (Galatians 4:4)
X	What is Aramaic for "Father"? A. Abba (Galatians 4:6)
X	In Galatians chapter 4, what does Paul plead with his brothers and sisters? A. Become like me (for I became like you) (Galatians 4:12)
X	To whom was Paul's illness a trial? A. Brothers and sisters (Galatians 4:14)
X	Two-part answer: In Galatians chapter 4, how did the brothers and sisters welcome Paul? A. 1) As if he were an angel of God and 2) As if he were Christ Jesus himself (Galatians 4:14)
X	Who did not treat Paul with contempt or scorn? A. Brothers and sisters (Galatians 4:14)
X	Two-part answer: In Galatians chapter 4, who had two sons? A. Abraham (Galatians 4:22)
X	Who was the result of a divine promise? A. Abraham's son by the free woman (Galatians 4:22-23)
X	From what Old Testament book is the following: "Get rid of the slave woman and her son, for the slave woman's son will never share in the inheritance with the free woman's son."? A. Genesis (Galatians 4:30)
X	In Galatians chapter 4, who stand for Mount Sinai and corresponds to the present city of Jerusalem? A. Hagar (Galatians 4:31)
X	What is in Arabia? A. Mount Sinai (Galatians 4:31)
X	Why are the Spirit and the flesh in conflict with each other? A. So that you are not to do whatever you want (Galatians 5:17)
X	Two-part question: Who will reap destruction and who will reap eternal life?

	A. 1) Whoever sows to please their flesh and 2) Whoever sows to please the Spirit (Galatians 6:8)
X	What did Paul use as he wrote to the Galatians with his own hand? A. Large letters (Galatians 6:11)
X	When did Paul use large letters? A. As he wrote to the Galatians with his own hand (Galatians 6:11)
X	In Ephesians chapter 1, where are the faithful in Christ Jesus? A. Ephesus (Ephesians 1:1)
X	Two-part answer: For what were we predestined in Ephesians chapter 1? A. 1) Adoption and sonship and 2) the praise of his glory (Ephesians 1:5, 11)
X	Two-part answer: To whom did Christ come and preach peace? A. 1) To you who were far away and 2) to those who were near (Ephesians 2:17)
X	What did Christ come and preach to those who were far away and to those who were near? A. Peace (Ephesians 2:17)
X	Complete, in essence, the following: "His intent was that now, through the church, ..." A. "...the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms" (Ephesians 3:10)
X	Two-part question: Who have deceitful scheming and what has deceitful desires? A. 1) People and 2) Your old self (Ephesians 4:14, 22)
X	Two-part answer: In Ephesians chapter 3, what are the Ephesians told to put off? A. 1) Their old self and 2) falsehood (Ephesians 4:22, 25)
X	Complete, in essence, the following: "Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds..." A. "...of darkness, but rather expose them" (Ephesians 5:11)
X	Complete, in essence, the verse that contains the unique word "radiant" A. And to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless (Ephesians 5:27)
X	Two-part question: Who does a man leave and who do children honor? A. Their father and mother (Ephesians 6:1-2, 5:31)
X	Complete, in essence, the verse that contains the unique word "shield" A. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one (Ephesians 6:16)
X	Who are named as servants of Christ Jesus? A. Paul and Timothy (Philippians 1:1)
X	Complete, in essence, the following: "For to me, to live is..." A. "...Christ and to die is gain" (Philippians 1:21)
X	Complete, in essence, the verse that contains the unique word "obedient" A. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death - even death on a cross!" (Philippians 2:8)
X	Complete, in essence, the following: "That at the name of Jesus every knee..." A. "...should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth" (Philippians 2:10)
X	Two-part question: What does Paul press on toward and what does Paul press on to take hold? A. 1) The goal and 2) that for which Christ Jesus took hold of Paul (Philippians 3:12, 14)

X	What is the destiny, god and glory of those who live as enemies of the cross of Christ? A. Their destiny is destruction, their god is their stomach and their glory is in their shame (Philippians 3:19)
X	In Philippians chapter 4, who are 3 people whose names are in the book of life? A. Euodia, Syntyche and Clement (Philippians 4:2-3)
X	While in what city did Paul receive aid more than once? A. Thessalonica (Philippians 4:16)
X	Two-part answer: What is growing throughout the whole world and in what are the Colossians growing? A. 1) The gospel and 2) the knowledge of God (Colossians 1:6, 10)
X	Two-part question: Who is the firstborn over all creation and who is the firstborn from among the dead? A. Christ (Colossians 1:15, 18)
X	Complete, in essence, the verse that contains the unique word 'Deity' A. For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form (Colossians 2:9)
X	Complete, in essence, the following: "Having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness..." A. "...which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross" (Colossians 2:14)
X	In Colossians chapter 3, what is greed? A. Idolatry (Colossians 3:5)
X	With what should God's chosen people clothe themselves? A. Compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience (Colossians 3:12)
X	In Colossians chapter 4, who is Paul's fellow prisoner? A. Aristarchus (Colossians 4:10)
X	Who are the only Jews among Paul's co-workers for the kingdom of God? A. Aristarchus, Mark (the cousin of Barnabas), and Jesus (who is called Justus) (Colossians 4:10-11)
X	What does "Onesimus" mean? A. Useful (Philemon 1:10)
X	What means "useful"? A. Onesimus (Philemon 1:10)
