Galatians 1:10	Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ.
Galatians 2:20	I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
Galatians 2:21	I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness could be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing!
Galatians 3:11	Clearly no one who relies on the law is justified before God, because “the righteous will live by faith.”
Galatians 3:13	Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole.”
Galatians 3:14	He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.
Galatians 3:28	There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
Galatians 3:29	If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.
Galatians 4:6	Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, “Abba, Father.”
Galatians 4:7	So you are no longer a slave, but God’s child; and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir.
Galatians 5:1	It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.
Galatians 5:6	For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision has any value. The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love.
Galatians 5:13	You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.
Galatians 5:14	For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: “Love your neighbor as yourself.”
Galatians 5:25	Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. 26Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other.
Galatians 6:1	Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently. But watch yourselves, or you also may be tempted.

Galatians 6:2	Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.
Galatians 6:7	Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.
Galatians 6:9	Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.
Galatians 6:10	Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.
Ephesians 1:3	Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.
Ephesians 1:18	I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people,
Ephesians 2:6	And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus
Ephesians 2:10	For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
Ephesians 2:19	Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household
Ephesians 3: 12	In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence.
Ephesians 4:2	Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.
Ephesians 4:3	Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.
Ephesians 4:16	From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.
Ephesians 4:29	Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.
Ephesians 4:30	And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
Ephesians 4:32	Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
Ephesians 5: 21	Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.
Ephesians 6: 1	Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.
Philippians 1:6	Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
Philippians 1:21	For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.
Philippians 1:29	For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe in him, but also to suffer for him
Philippians 2:3	Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves
Philippians 2:4	Not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

Philippians 2:14	Do everything without grumbling or arguing
Philippians 3:7	But whatever were gains to me I now consider loss for the sake of Christ.
Philippians 3:8	What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ
Philippians 3:12	Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.
Philippians 4:4	Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
Philippians 4:8	Finally , brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.
Philippians 4:12	I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want.
Philippians 4:13	I can do all this through him who gives me strength.
Philippians 4:19	And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.
Colossians 1:13	For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves
Colossians 1:15	The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.
Colossians 1:16	For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him.
Colossians 2:8	See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ.
Colossians 3:4	When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.
Colossians 3:12	Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
Colossians 3:13	Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
Colossians 3:14	And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
Colossians 3:15	Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.
Colossians 3:23	Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters
Colossians 4:2	Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.
Colossians 4:5	Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity.

Colossians 4:6	Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.
Philemon 1:6	I pray that your partnership with us in the faith may be effective in deepening your understanding of every good thing we share for the sake of Christ.
Philemon 1:11	Formerly he was useless to you, but now he has become useful both to you and to me.

<u>Galatians 1:11-12</u>	<u>I want you</u> to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel I preached is not of human origin. I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it; rather, I received it by revelation from Jesus Christ.
<u>Galatians 2:15-16</u>	<u>We</u> who are Jews by birth and not sinful Gentiles know that a person is not justified by the works of the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no one will be justified.
Galatians 5:16-17	<u>So I</u> say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.
Galatians 5:22-23	<u>But</u> the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.
Ephesians 1:4-6	<u>For he</u> chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will— to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.
Ephesians 1:22-23	<u>And God</u> placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.
<u>Ephesians 2:8-9</u>	<u>For it</u> is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast.
Ephesians 3:10-11	<u>His</u> intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms, according to his eternal purpose that he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord.
Ephesians 3:20-21	<u>Now</u> to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
Ephesians 4:4-6	<u>There</u> is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.
Ephesians 4:26-27	<u>“In your anger</u> do not sin”: Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold.

<u>Ephesians 5:1-2</u>	<u>Follow</u> God’s example, therefore, as dearly loved children and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.
Ephesians 6:2-3	<u>“Honor</u> your father and mother”—which is the first commandment with a promise— “so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.”
Ephesians 6:7-8	<u>Serve</u> wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not people, because you know that the Lord will reward each one for whatever good they do, whether they are slave or free.
Ephesians 6:10-11	<u>Finally</u> , be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes.
Philippians 2:5-6	<u>In your relationships</u> with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage
Philippians 2:9-11	<u>Therefore</u> God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
Philippians 3:10-11	<u>I want to</u> know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead.
Philippians 3:13-14	<u>Brothers</u> and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.
<u>Philippians 4:6-7</u>	<u>Do</u> not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
<u>Colossians 1:18-19</u>	<u>And he</u> is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy. For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him
Colossians 2:6-7	<u>So then</u> , just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.
Colossians 2:13-14	<u>When</u> you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross.
<u>Colossians 3:1-2</u>	<u>Since</u> , then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.
