- **But to** you who are listening I say:
- Love your enemies,
- do good to those who hate you,
- bless those who curse you,
- pray for those who mistreat you. (6:27-28)

- **Do to** others
- as you would have them do to you. (6:31)

28

- **But love** your enemies,
- do good to them, and lend to them
- without expecting to get anything back.
- Then your reward will be great,
- and you will be children of the Most High,
- because he is kind to the ungrateful
- and wicked. (6:35)

- Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore,
- to send out workers
- into his harvest field." (10:2)

41

- **He answered**, "Love the Lord your God
- with all your heart
- and with all your soul
- and with all your strength
- and with all your mind';
- and, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" (10:27)

43

- **So I** say to you:
- Ask and it will be given to you;
- seek and you will find;
- knock and the door will be opened to you.
- For everyone who asks receives;
- the one who seeks finds;
- and to the one who knocks,
- the door will be opened. (11:9-10)

45

- **I tell** you,
- whoever publicly acknowledges me before others,
- the Son of Man will also acknowledge before the angels of God.
- But whoever disowns me before others
- will be disowned before the angels of God. (12:8-9)

47

- **But seek** his kingdom,
- and these things will be given to you as well. (12:31)

- **All** things have been committed

- and those who humble themselves
- will be exalted. (14:11)

53

- **And whoever** does not carry their cross
- and follow me
- cannot be my disciple. (14:27)

- **Suppose** one of you has a hundred sheep
- and loses one of them.
- Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine
- in the open country
- and go after the lost sheep
- until he finds it? (15:4)

55

- **I tell** you that in the same way
- there will be more rejoicing in heaven
- over one sinner who repents
- than over ninety-nine righteous persons
- who do not need to repent. (15:7)

56

- **No** one can serve two masters.
- Either you will hate the one
- and love the other,
- or you will be devoted to the one
- and despise the other.
- You cannot serve both God and money. (16:13)

57

- **He said to him,**
- "If they do not listen
- to Moses and the Prophets,
- they will not be convinced
- even if someone rises
- from the dead." (16:31)

58

- **Once**, on being asked by the Pharisees
- when the kingdom of God would come,
- Jesus replied, "The coming
- of the kingdom of God
- is not something that can be observed,
- nor will people say, 'Here it is,'
- or 'There it is,'
- because the kingdom of God
- is in your midst." (17:20-21)

- **Father,** if you are willing,
- take this cup from me;

- **He is** not here; he has risen!
- Remember how he told you,
- while he was still with you in Galilee:
- 'The Son of Man must be delivered
- over to the hands of sinners,
- be crucified and on the third day
- be raised again.'
- Then they remembered his words. (24:6-8)

75

- **He said to them**,
- "This is what I told you
- while I was still with you:
- Everything must be fulfilled
- that is written about me
- in the Law of Moses,
- the Prophets and the Psalms." (24:44)

76

- **Then he opened** their minds
- so they could understand the Scriptures.
- He told them, "This is what is written:
- The Messiah will suffer
- and rise from the dead on the third day,
- and repentance for the forgiveness of sins
- will be preached in his name
- to all nations,
- beginning at Jerusalem." (24:45-47)

- **I am** going to send you
- what my Father has promised;
- but stay in the city
- until you have been clothed with
- power
- from on high. (24:49)
